- Educational Fee: varies by state of residency

  - Out-of-State Resident \$646.10 per credit hour
- Activity Facility Fee: \$31.41 per credit hour (maximum charge of \$322.35 after 10 credit hours).
- Health Service Fee: \$79.00 per academic semester.
- Information Technology Fee: \$12.20 per credit hour (no maximum charge).

Educational & Information Technology Fees are assessed on a per credit hour basis.

An additional Supplemental Course Fee will apply for the following and will be charged per credit hour:

- Engineering Supplemental Course Fee of \$60.00 per credit hour will be charged to all students enrolled in engineering courses, except for courses offered in Geology & Geophysics. Co-listed courses are subject to the Engineering Supplemental Course Fee.
- Science Supplemental Course Fee of \$60.00 per credit hour will be charged to all students enrolled in Computer Science, Biological Science, Geology and Geophysics courses. Co-listed courses are subject to the Science Supplemental Course Fee.
- Science Supplemental Course Fee of \$30.00 per credit hour will be charged to all students enrolled in Physics courses. Co-listed courses are subject to the Science Supplemental Course Fee.
- Business, IST and M&IS Supplemental Course Fee of \$30.00 per credit hour will be charged to all students enrolled in Business, IST and M&IS courses. Co-listed courses are subject to the Science Supplemental Course Fee

Courses audited will be counted at their normal credit value in computing the amount of fees to be paid. Students enrolling in "zero credit" courses are required to pay all fees according to the equivalent credit for the course.

A minimum of \$250.00 Sponsored Student Fee per semester will be assessed to International Third Party Sponsored Students.

Health insurance is mandatory for all international students and is charged to your student account as part of your cost of attendance. Admission for international students is conditional upon purchase of health insurance. Total cost is \$920 per regular academic year and \$185 per summer semester.

The University reserves the right to modify by increase or decrease the fees charged for attendance and other services to the University, including but not limited to educational fees, at any time when in the discretion of the governing board the same is in the best interest of the University, provided that no increases can or will be effective unless approved by the Curators of the University of Missouri not less than thirty days prior to the beginning of the academic term (semester, etc.) to which the fees are applicable, with all modification of fees to be effective irrespective as to whether fees have or have not been paid by on or behalf of a student prior to the effective date of the modification.

## Scholarships and Financial Assistance

help **YOU** meet costs!

Scholarships at Missouri S&T are many and varied. Some of the most prestigious scholarships are awarded early, allowing Missouri S&T to send out individual financial assistance awards to students in late December.

### To apply for merit-based awards:

Submit an application for admission online at [apply.mst.edu](http://apply.mst.edu) before the December 1 priority application date.

### To apply for need-based federal and most state aid:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Priority for most programs given to students submitting the FAFSA by **March 1**.

While there are no true deadlines for need-based aid, early application is encouraged. First consideration for certain limited programs is given to those students submitting the FAFSA in January and February. Students applying any other time of the year will be awarded on a funds-available basis.

All students are strongly encouraged to complete the FAFSA to determine their eligibility for federal financial aid.

Dates to remember for incoming first-time freshmen:

## December 1: Priority Application Deadline for Admission and Scholarships.

Scholarships are awarded on a funds-available basis after December 1.

Rolling applications for admission will be accepted and reviewed until July 1.

## March 1: Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) either online or the paper application to qualify for need-based assistance.

## Early April: Final scholarship and financial assistance award letters are mailed to students.

## July 15: First billing statement due for upcoming fall academic semester.
